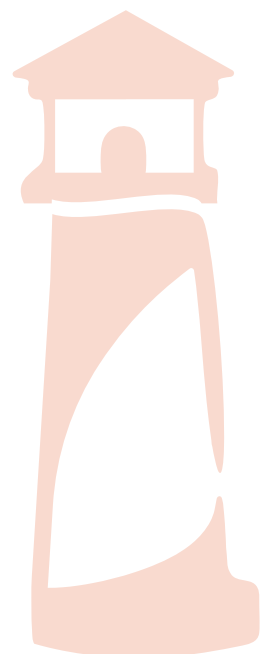

Setup & Load-In

Arrival Time: Setup runs from 7:00 AM – 8:45 AM

Location: Seabreeze Amphitheater, Carlin Park
400 Jimmy Buffett Mem Hwy, Jupiter, FL 33477

Load-In Instructions:

- Pull into the loading zone, pull off to the West side on the grass, and unload to your booth space.
 - Do not block traffic. It's a **one-way loop** and vendor cars need to get through.
 - Once you've unloaded, pull forward (it's one-way) and follow the signs to park in Coral Lot.
 - Vehicles must be out of loading zone and parked in Coral Lot by **8:45 AM. No exceptions.**

Parking

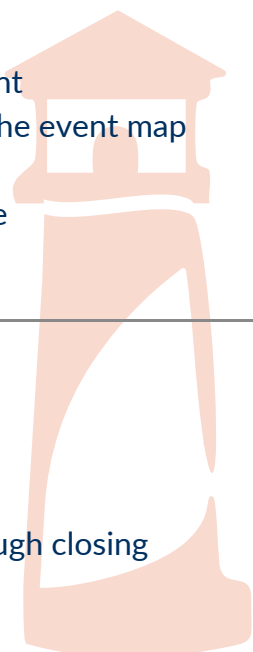
A parking attendant will be on site to direct you through the loading zone and guide you to Coral Lot, the vendor parking area. Vendor parking is on the northwest side of the venue, just around the corner from the amphitheater - please see the attached page for the parking map.

Your Booth Space

- Your booth number will be emailed the week of the market
 - Look for a numbered sign on the ground at your designated space
 - Line your tent up with the sign and center it to the peak of your tent
 - Booths are placed side by side on grass - familiarize yourself with the event map
 - Tents are required unless otherwise approved in advance
 - Please check in upon arrival by scanning the QR code at your space
 - Booth numbers are subject to minor day-of adjustments if needed

Breakdown

- Breakdown begins at **3:00 PM**
- All vendors must be fully packed up and offsite by **4:30 PM**
- No early breakdown allowed - all vendors must remain set up through closing
- No sales permitted after **3:15 PM**

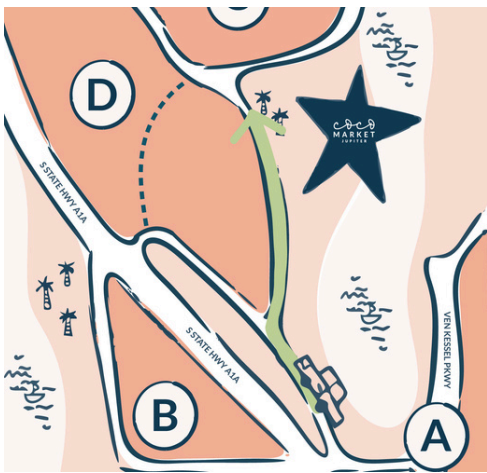

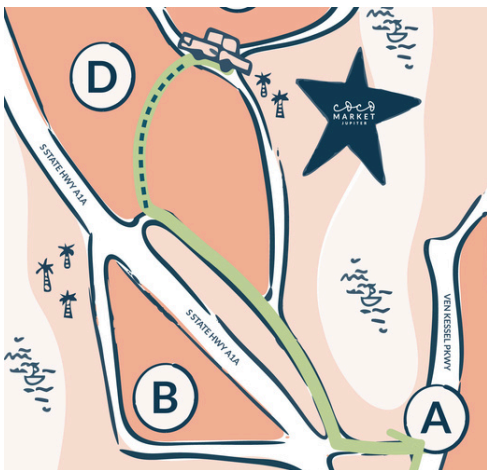
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Your Role as a Vendor

Code of Conduct

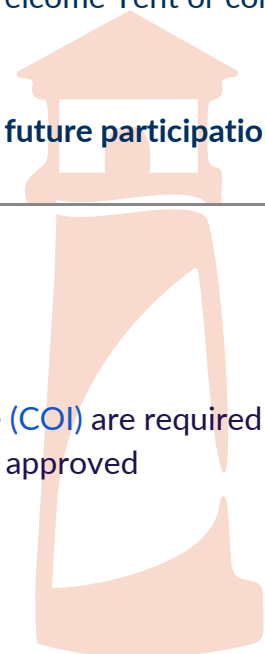
We are committed to maintaining a kind, respectful, and inclusive environment for all. As a vendor, you agree to:

- **Be Kind & Professional:** Treat everyone with respect; harassment or aggressive behavior is not tolerated
- **Engage Gently:** No aggressive selling or pressure tactics
- **Respect Booth Boundaries:** Promote only from your designated space
- **Maintain Safety:** Keep your booth clear of hazards and follow health guidelines
- **Leave No Trace:** Clean your area completely and respect the venue
- **Follow Emergency Protocols:** For any emergency, report to the Welcome Tent or contact Corey (561-870-4090)

Violations may result in removal from the event or disqualification from future participation.

Application Process

- All vendors must apply at cocomarket.org for each event
- The vendor fee is \$200 for each event
- A signed vendor agreement and approved [Certificate of Insurance \(COI\)](#) are required
- Spots are not guaranteed until payment and COI are received and approved

Event Checklist



What to Bring

Must-Haves

- ☐ 10x10 tent (unless approved otherwise)
- ☐ **30 lb. weights on each tent leg (required)**
- ☐ Table(s), tablecloth(s), and signage
- ☐ Products/services + payment system
- ☐ Phone & charger
- ☐ Certificate of Insurance (COI) submitted and approved

Helpful Extras

- ☐ Chairs
- ☐ Cart/dolly for easier load-in
- ☐ Water, snacks, sunscreen
- ☐ Extension cords (if using approved electricity)
- ☐ Fans or cooling items (summer months)
- ☐ Rain gear or tent sides, change of clothes
- ☐ Pool noodles (to put on each upper corner & leg of your tent to stop rain from pooling up)
- ☐ Trash bag (leave no trace)

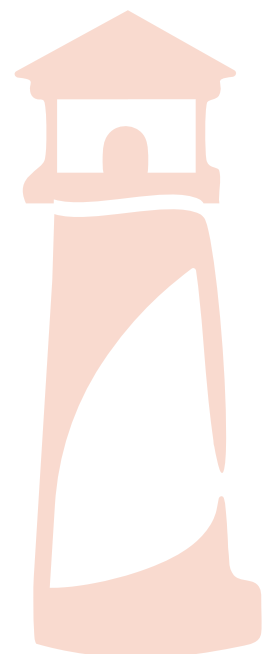
Day Of Information

Arrival&Setup

- ☐ Arrive by 7:00–8:00 AM, move car by 8:45 AM
- ☐ Find your booth, line tent peak with ground sign
- ☐ Check in via QR code at your booth
- ☐ Stay set up until market ends at 3 PM (2 PM in summer)

Breakdown

- ☐ Pack fully before bringing vehicle
- ☐ No early breakdown
- ☐ Leave space clean



Do I need to apply for every market, or just once? You'll need to submit a new application for each market through cocomarket.org. This helps us thoughtfully curate each event and maintain a balanced lineup.

When is payment due?

Payment is due once your application is approved. Your spot is not reserved until both payment and a valid [Certificate of Insurance \(COI\)](#) are received and approved.

What is the Premium Booth Option?

We offer a Premium Booth Option for vendors who wish to select their specific booth location. This option is available for an additional fee and must be requested in advance. Availability is limited and granted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Is electricity available?

Electricity is available for approved food vendors. If you are not a food vendor and require access to power, it must be noted in your application and approved ahead of time. All cords must be covered at all times.

Can I share a booth with another vendor?

No — shared booths are not allowed. Each vendor must apply, be approved, and pay individually. This policy ensures clarity, fairness, and consistency across the market.

What happens if it rains?

Coco Market is a rain-or-shine event. In the case of severe weather that impacts safety, we will notify vendors by email and text with updates. Otherwise, plan to be there — rain boots and good vibes welcome.

Can I request a specific booth location?

Yes! We have a Premium Vendor option where you can select your specific space for an additional fee.

Do I still need insurance if I'm only sampling or offering services?

Yes. All vendors must provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI) regardless of what you're selling or offering. The COI must name both Cocoyogi Inc. and the City of Delray Beach as Additional Insured. See the COI Guidelines for full details.



FAQs (cont'd)



What if I'm running late on market day?

Please text the coordinator as soon as possible. Cars must be out of loading zones by 8:45 AM, if you arrive late, you'll need to park in the garage and carry in your materials by hand.

Can I rent tent weights or equipment on-site?

We do not offer tent weight rentals. 30 lb. weights on each tent leg are required for safety and are the vendor's responsibility. Unweighted tents will not be permitted to remain up.

Do you offer refunds if I cancel?

Vendor fees are non-refundable. If you experience an emergency or illness, reach out to us directly, we handle those situations on a case-by-case basis.

How do I get featured on Coco Market's social media or website?

All approved vendors are featured on our website and Instagram before the event. Be sure your application includes a high-resolution logo, social handle, and a clear, engaging business description.

What's the vibe of Coco Market? How should I set up my booth?

Coco Market is warm, vibrant, and wellness-focused. We love booths that are clean, intentional, and visually aligned with conscious living. Think calming signage, beautiful displays, and items that reflect your brand's energy. Be approachable, be proud - your presence is part of what makes the market magical.
